SROI offers a new way to measure and account for the value your work creates. It is attracting a lot of interest from funders, government and voluntary sector organisations. SROI shares the same initial stages as the CES approach, particularly with regard to identifying outcomes, indicators and collecting data. This free introductory briefing will explain what SROI is and how it is used, and will introduce participants to the six stages needed to conduct an SROI.

- enable participants to make a more informed choice as to whether SROI
